Struggling for Reforming of the Examination System. Vice Chancellor

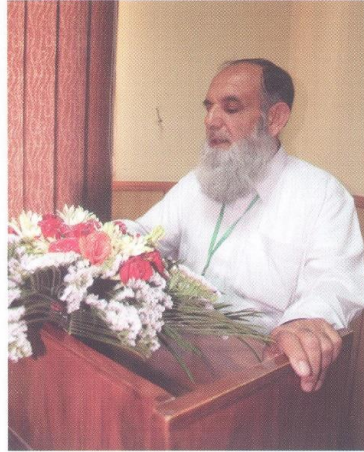

University of Balochistan Quetta has achieved the smart project. A notification in this regard has been issued by

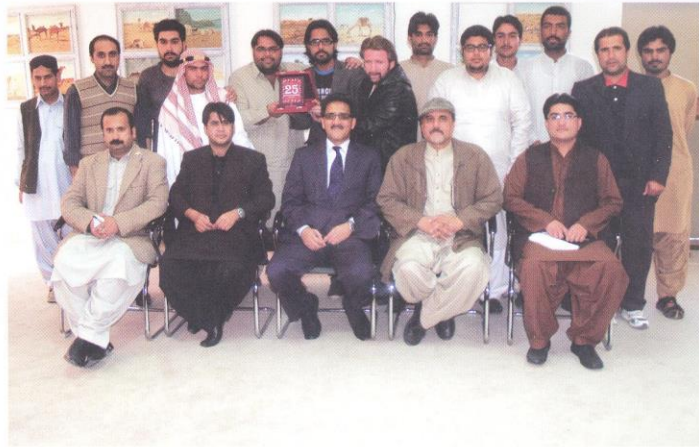
the Higher Education Commission. This is an honor for the province of Balochistan and for University of
