

Federal Minister for Planning and Development, Ahsan Iqbal has said that Balochistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KPK) Provinces were being given special priority in China-Pak Economic Corridor (CPEC) Projects, adding that US \$35 billion out of US \$46 billion of CPEC would be spent on energy production projects.















He said that Balochistan was ignored in past in term of development and added that we all of us were responsible for this negligence. "Balochistan is also being given special priority in Prime Minister, Muhammad Nawaz Sharif Vision Program 2025," he said. He was addressing ceremony held in connection with inauguration of different projects executed at the University of Balochistan, Quetta in collaboration with Higher Education Commission (HEC). Earlier, he inaugurated these projects.

The Federal Minister said that 650 kilometers long Gawadar-Quetta road project will be completed by December this year and added that work on new international airport in port town of Gawadar has been started.

"We have asked the Provincial Government to submit their plans or proposed industrial zones along CPEC," he said. "Development projects being executed in Balochistan funded by the Federal Government would be completed in time."

Minister labal said that we would have to adopt a positive thinking and mindset to obtain goals of progress and prosperity. Replying to question asked by teachers and students of the varsity, the Federal Minister said, "There will be no chance in the designs of CPEC. Work on western



route of CPEC in underway".

He said that work on ongoing development projects in port town of Gawadar including International Airport, free trade zone, and five star hotels, modern hospital, supply of potable drinking water, conational training center and others was underway. "Primer Nawaz Sharif will soon inaugurate the projects being completed in Gawadar in near future," he said.


















Rector International Islamic University Islamabad Dr. Masoom Yasinzi said that we would have to improve our education standard. It is need of hour to implement same syllabus in public

Mrs. Asifi's Tireless Efforts in Brining Education to the Most Underprivileged Afghan Refugee Girls

The UNHCR Nansen Refugee Award Laureate, Ageela Asifi has said that investing in education means investing in the future of a nation, without which no country could develop and prosper.



She was addressing a gathering organized in her honor by the UN Refugee Agency and its partner agency WESS at the University of Balochistan. The event was held to pay tribute to Mrs. Asifi's tireless efforts in brining education to some of the most underprivileged Afghan Refugee girls. Mrs. Asifi was on a three day mission to Balochistan for the first time. Her visit was aimed at highlighting the importance of education of children in exile. During her stay, she also visited Saranan Refugee Village, where she held meetings with community elders, teachers, students and their parents.

In her interaction with refugee teachers and parents, Mrs. Asifi underlined that children and youth who are not in schools, do not benefit from their interntionally established right to basic education and are at greater risk of exploitation, including early marriage and child labour.

On the last day of her visit Aqeela Asifi attended an event at the University of Balochistan. Asifi in her address noted that an educational system should not only be focusing on teaching young people how to make a living but also teach them how to make a life. "Only then we would achieve our objective of a progressive society."

Also present at the occasion were Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Javed Iqbal, Aghan Consul General Waheedullah Momand, Secretory Education Balochsitan Saboor Kakar and Chief Executive WESS, Pervez Iqbal and a huge number of students.

Commissioner Afghan Refugees in Balochistan, Brig (Retd.) Masud Ahmed in his speech also highlighted the importance of giving refugee children access to education. He said, "Educated refugees provide leadership in displacement situations and in rebuilding communities, recovering from conflict. Education provides knowledge and skill development that strengthen the capacity of our future generation to be agents of social transformation". Speaking at the occasion, Dinesh Shrestha, Head of UNHCR in Balochistan said, that ensuring the provision of education to refugee children is a core component of UNHCR's work both nationally and internationally. "Quality education that inculcates relevant skills and knowledge enables refugees to lives and builds skills of self-reliance." He added.
