#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

#### (To be retained by the Candidate after Receipt of his/her roll number)

- 1. Candidates may bring their drawing instruments with them for their examination in Mathematics. No kind of rules or instrument is to be used in either the sketch or the finished Drawing. Physics & Chemistry candidates may use stencils.
- 2. Conduct in the Hall: Every day before the Examination begins the Superintendent or the Deputy Superintendent shall call upon all the candidates to search their pockets par-with & deliver to him/her all papers, books or notes, which they may have their possession. No late-Corner shall be admitted unless the warning has been repeated to him/her at the gate. The Superintendent or the deputy Superintendent or both as the case may by, shall forward to the Controller every day declaration signed by him/her or them & witnessed by all the invigilator then on duly to the effect that he/she did as a matter of fact upon the candidates to search pockets & to surrender all papers books or notes in their possession.
- 3. **Unfair-Means:** Any candidate who after announcement failed to part-with or is found to have in his/her possession or accessible to him/her, papers, books or notes relating to the subjects or Examination of that paper or detected in giving or receiving assistance, or using or attempting to use any other unfair-mean in connection with the examination, shall be expelled by the Superintendent of the Centre from the examination room.
- 5. If a Candidate is found having in his/her possession or accessible to him/her, papers, books or notes which might possibly be of assistance to him/her he/she shall:-
- 6. If it is found that his/her possession of such books, notes or papers was due to inadvertence and was implication of moral turpitude and in other cases or possession be disqualified from passing any examination that year
- 7. Any Candidate detected in giving or receiving assistance or found guilty of copying from any other unfair notes, or allowing any other candidate to copy his/her answer-book, or using or attempting to use these or any other unfair-means shall be disqualified from passing any examination for a period not exceeding three years.
- 8. Not with standing any other law for the time being in force & without prejudice to any remedy open to the University under such law:
- 9. Any candidate found guilty of deliberate previous arrangements to cheat in the examination such as smuggling another answer-book, impersonation or misconduct or misconduct of serious nature and the person who impersonates as such candidate if he/she is on the rolls of affiliated college shall be disqualified for a period of three years. His/hers entire result would be cancelled and FIR would be lodged.
- 10. Any candidate obtaining admission to be examination on the false representation made on his/her application form or using abusive or obscene in the answer-book shall be debarred from taking any University Examination for a period of one year, Any candidate forging another person's signatures on his/her application or his/her Examination form shall be disqualified.

#### **DIRECTTIONS FOR CANDIDATE**

#### Admission to the Hall.

- 1. a) The doors shall be opened each day half an hour before the time specified for the distribution of the question papers. All the candidates must be in the examination hall before the time fixed for the commencement of the examination. The superintendent shall permit a candidate, to take the examination provisionally, if the candidate is not more than 15 minutes late.
  - b) Except under exceptional circumstances, the superintendent shall have option to admit a candidate to the examination hall after 15 minutes unless he/she is satisfied that the candidate was delayed by a cause beyond his/her control in which case he/she may provisionally admit a candidate up to half an hour from the commencement of the examination, after which no candidate shall be admitted to the examination hall for any reason whatsoever.
  - c) The candidate must sign a statement to the effect that his/her admission to the examination is provisional and that he/she will have no claim to have his/her script valued in case the syndicate does not approve of his/her admission to the examination hall.
  - d) Such report should invariably be furnished in a prescribed memo, copies of which will be supplied by the superintendent of the examination Centre.
  - e) No candidate is permitted to leave the room until the expiry of half the time after the distribution of the paper. Candidate leaving the Examination Hall before the half time shall not be allowed to take their question paper with them

#### Seating arrangement.

- A seat with a number will be allotted to each candidate, Candidates will be required to find out and occupy their allotted seats.
- 3. The order in which the candidate are seated will be forwarded to the examiner. Should a candidate be discovered to have copied from another, he/she will be externed from the examination as well as the candidate from whom he/she copied if there is reason to suppose that the copying was connived the later.
- 4. No candidate without special permission of the officer-in-charge shall leave his/her seat or the examination room until the end of the examination. No candidate shall speak without permission if it be necessary for the candidate to communicate with the superintendent, he/she would stand up in his/her place and the officer-in-charge will see to his/her query.
- 5. Before beginning his/her answers, each candidate shall write on the title page of his/her answer-book the following viz, the subject, the name of the paper, & his/her Roll Number. When the time allowed has expired the book must be delivered to the superintendent, even though the candidate may not have answered any part of the paper.
- 6. All candidates, are required to provide their own pens and blue black ink. Answers shall be written in the books supplied to the candidates, and on both side of the paper. No candidate shall tear a leaf out of answerbook Blotting paper will be supplied.

No paper of any kind is to be removed from the Examination hall except the question paper.

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- 7. Any Candidate found guilty of disclosing his/her identity or making peculiar marks in his/her answer book for that purpose shall:
  - a) If he/she is successful in the examination, be disqualified from passing the examination that year.
  - b) If unsuccessful in the examination, be disqualified for that ear & the following years:-
- 8. Candidate guilty of communicating, or attempting to communicate, with Examiner with the object of influencing them in the award of their marks shall be deerned to have used, or attempted to use, unfair means shall be punished.
  - **Explanation:-** An approach made by a relative, guardian or a friend of a candidate will as a rule be considered to on behalf of the candidate who shall be punished. The making of an appeal to the examiner through an answer-book by a candidate is prohibited. The answer paper in which such an appeal is made shall be liable to be cancelled.
- 9. Any candidate who refuses to obey the superintendent of an examination hall or changes his/her seat with another candidate or change he/her Roll Number or creates disturbance of any kind during examination or otherwise misbehaves in or around any examination hall shall be liable to expulsion by superintendent or the controller of inspector of a Centre of any office duly authorized by the Controller as well as any of the following Punishments according to the seriousness of the offences:
  - *a)* Entire result shall be cancelled.
  - b) Disqualification for one year.
  - c) Penalty would be imposed.
- 10. The Superintendent of the examination hall shall report without delay each detail with evidence & explanation of the candidate for final orders of the University.
- 11. Any candidate found in possession of fire-arms or anything capable of being used as a weapon of offense in or around the examination hall, shall be liable to expulsion by the officer and to disqualification ranging between two and three years.
- 12. In the case of the alleged use of unfair means in connection with examinations, if in the opinion of the Vice Chancellor facts have been brought to light within 30 days of the receipt of the decision by the candidate which had they been before the committee, might have induced them to come to a decision other than the arrived at, then the vice chancellor may order that such facts be reduced to writing and placed before the committee. The committee shall then reconsider the case. A unanimous decision of the Committee shall be final. But in the event of a difference of opinion the case shall be referred to the Vice Chancellor, who may finally decide the case himself of refer it to the Syndicate for final decision as he thinks fit.
